This letter confirms your registration in the 2026 SISCO Fall Field Tour, Sept 22-24, based in Nelson. The agenda timeline is Tuesday Sept 22 Afternoon/Evening: Registration and Social Get Together; Wednesday Sept 23 and Thursday Sept 24: full days in the field.

Your registration includes lunches and refreshment breaks each day, the banquet on Wednesday evening, your transportation during the field tour, your nametag and your field tour booklet.

REGISTRATION COMPLETION AND SOCIAL GET -TOGETHER

Please complete your registration by signing in with the registrar at Touchstone Gallery Museum located on the corner of Vernon Street and Ward Street on Tuesday from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm. There will be a social get-together in the Gallery with hosted snacks and beverages available by donation – **PLEASE BRING CASH.**

If you are completing your registration on Wednesday morning be at the Walmart Parking lot by 7:00 am

MARSHALLING POINT EACH DAY

The marshalling point for departure each morning and return each afternoon is the Walmart Parking. The buses will be easy to spot and there will be a Bus Captain directing you where to park your vehicle. There is no charge for parking. Please be there by 7:15 am, the buses leave at 7:30 am.

We ask that you please do not drive your own vehicle on this field tour (unless you are a speaker, you are with Selkirk College, or you have previously discussed a necessary exception with SISCO Admin).

BREAKFAST OPTIONS

The hotels hosting our delegates have restaurants that don't open until 7:00am; exception is the Adventure Hotel which is associated with the only cafe in Nelson that opens at 6am - Empire Coffee, 616 Vernon Street. They have breakfast options AND you can pre-order your breakfast online: <https://www.empirecoffee.ca/> for pick up right at 6am.

Our morning coffee breaks in the field feature coffee, breakfast pastries, fresh fruit and energy bars.

THE BANQUET

Our banquet is at the Proctor Community Hall. **Please tell me by reply to email if you will NOT be attending the banquet** so we know if one of the buses will return to Nelson early. **Please bring CASH** if you want to purchase beverages at the banquet.

FOOD DIETARY RESTRICTIONS

Those of you who have indicated food restrictions on your registration – please ask for location of special lunches that have been made for your dietary restriction, and the food will be labelled at the banquet.

YOUR DRINKING WATER IN THE FIELD

We don't provide bottled water; please fill your own water bottle each morning and bring it with you.
